

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

City of Fort Smith, Arkansas

Separate sealed bids for **FCRA Sewer and Fire Protection Improvements, Project No. 18-12-C1**, will be received by the City of Fort Smith, Arkansas, **at the Office of the Director of Utilities** until **10:00 a.m.** (Local Time), **Tuesday, December 18, 2018** and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed "**City of Fort Smith, Utility Department, 801 Carnall Avenue, Suite 500, Fort Smith, Arkansas 72901**" and shall be labeled **bid for FCRA Sewer and Fire Protection Improvements, Project No. 18-12-C1**. Bidders are to include their Arkansas License number on the outside of their sealed bid. **Bids shall only be received from registered Bidders.**

The project includes installation of 8,665 linear-feet (LF) of 8-inch cured in place pipe (CIPP), 660 LF of 10-inch CIPP, 399 LF of 10-inch PVC by open cut, 28 LF of 8-inch PVC spot repairs by open cut, five (5) concrete manholes, twenty (20) fiberglass manhole inserts, twenty-six (26) fire hydrants, and site restoration.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
