## **INVITATION TO BID**

Sealed Bids addressed to the Little Rock Water Reclamation Commission acting by and through Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority, will be received at the Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority Clearwater Maintenance Training Room, ATTN: Tonya Wallace, Program Supervisor, 5300 South Shackleford, Little Rock, Arkansas 72204, until 2:00 P.M. LOCAL TIME, March 13, 2018, and then publicly opened and read aloud immediately after specified closing time, for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and performing all Work required to construct the Adams Field Water Reclamation Facility: Parallel Treatment. Sealed envelopes or packages containing bids shall be marked or endorsed "Adams Field Water Reclamation Facility: Parallel Treatment, OWNERS Project No. 7130300" and the Contractor's Arkansas License Number shall be clearly marked on the outside of the envelope.

Bids received later than the specified time and date will be returned to the bidder unopened. Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority will not be held responsible for late, lost or misdirected bids. The opened bids will then be officially reviewed, evaluated, and recommended for award to the Little Rock Water Reclamation Commission thereafter.

The Project provides for the construction of improvements at an existing water reclamation facility located in Little Rock, AR. The project consist of: demolition, pipe relocation, electrical and fiber relocation, modifications to existing blower building, aeration basins, secondary clarifiers, and disinfection building, constructing new RAS pump station, filtration and disinfection facility, effluent pump station, non-potable pump station, electrical building and other minor structures; drainage improvements, roadway improvements, site lighting, electrical improvements, instrumentation improvements, site restoration and grading; and other miscellaneous work thereto at the Treatment Facility.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on March 2, 2018 at 2:00 pm at the LRWRA Clearwater Maintenance Training Room, 5300 South Shackleford, Little Rock, Arkansas 72204. A guided site tour or the Adams Field Facility will immediately follow. All bidders are encouraged to attend.

Any contract or contracts awarded under this invitation for bids will be subject to the requirements of the Arkansas Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) Programs as administered by the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission and as described in the contract documents.

All bid proposals, as well as the Bid Bond, must be made on the printed document forms included in the specifications. The submitted bid shall not be altered, withdrawn, or resubmitted within 60 calendar days from and after the date of the bid opening. Bid Bond Documents submitted with contract must be on the forms provided in the bid packets.

Contractor's Bid shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check upon a national or state bank in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total maximum Bid Price, payable without recourse to the Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority, or a Bid Bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company, as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a Contract and execute Performance and Payment Bonds within ten (10) days after Notice of Award of Contract. The Notice of Award of Contract shall be given by the Owner within 90 days following the opening of Bids.

The successful Bidder must furnish a Performance and Payment Bond upon the forms provided in the amount of One Hundred Percent (100%) of the Contract Price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Arkansas to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

The Contract Documents, consisting of Advertisement for Bids, Information for Bidders, Bid Form, Bid Bond, Agreement, Performance Bond, Payment Bond, Supplemental General Conditions, General Conditions, Wage Rates, Drawings, Specifications, and Addenda may be examined at the following locations:

Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive defects in bids.

Minority and small business vendors or contractors are encouraged to bid on any and all Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority projects.

Attention of Bidders is particularly called to the requirement as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wages to be paid under the Contract as incorporated in these Specifications.

Bidders are cautioned that Bids for this Project are subject to compliance with Arkansas Law for construction of Public Works as found in Arkansas Code Annotated 22-9-101, etc. The Bidder shall thoroughly acquaint himself and comply with the provisions of these Acts.

The right is reserved, as the interest of the Owner may require, to reject any or all Bids and to waive any formalities in Bids received. Bidders must be licensed in compliance with Arkansas Contractor's Licensing Law found in Arkansas Code 17-25-101, etc. Bids must comply with Arkansas Act 150 of 1965.

All parties to this contract shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, sex, age, religion, national origin, disability, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity, genetic information, political opinions or affiliation, military status, or other status protected by applicable law.

All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order 11246, as amended. The requirements for Bidders and Contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.

Each Bidder must comply with the requirements, terms, and conditions of the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission, the Disadvantaged, Minority and Women Business Enterprise (DBE/MBE/WBE) requirements, the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2014 (Public Law 113-76) including the "American Iron and Steel (AIS)" requirement, Labor Standards and Equal Employment Opportunity provisions during the performance of this contract. The Bidder commits itself to the requirements for the participation contained herein and all other requirements, terms, and conditions of these bid conditions by submitting a properly signed Bid.
