

## INVITATION TO BID

Separate sealed bids for **North Main Street Sidewalk Improvements (HWEI Project No. 2017059)**, will be received by the City of Dyer at the offices of Hawkins-Weir Engineers, Inc., 110 South 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Van Buren, Arkansas 72956 until 10 a.m. (local time), on April 30, 2019, at which time and location bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed "City of Dyer, Arkansas, c/o Hawkins-Weir Engineers, Inc., 110 South 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Van Buren, Arkansas 72956" and shall be labeled "Bid for North Main Street Sidewalk Improvements, Dyer, Arkansas". Any bid received after the scheduled opening time will be returned unopened.

This project includes the construction of approximately 630 linear-feet of concrete sidewalk along North Main Street, Dyer, Arkansas.

"Buy America" provisions apply to this project and shall be in accordance with ArDOT's Standard Specification Section 106 and 23 *CFR* § 635.410.

A complete set of Bid Documents includes one (1) set of construction drawings and one (1) set of project specifications, which may be purchased from the Engineer located at the address above upon payment of \$100.00 for each set. The payment shall not be refundable.

Bidders will be required to inform themselves of all Addenda duly issued in accordance with the requirements provided in the Instructions to Bidders. Information regarding the number of Addenda that have been duly issued can be obtained from Hawkins-Weir Engineers.

Each Bidder must deposit with their Bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

The City of Dyer, Arkansas, reserves the right to waive any informalities and reject any and all Bids. Bids shall remain firm for a period not to exceed 60 days from the Bid opening date.

The City of Dyer, Arkansas hereby notifies all Bidders that this contract is subject to applicable labor laws, non-discrimination provisions and other federal laws including the Fair Labor Standards Acts of 1938. The Work Hours Act of 1962 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 also apply.

The City of Dyer, Arkansas, encourages participation of small, minority, and woman owned business enterprises in the procurement of goods, services, and construction, as either a general contractor or subcontractor.
