

INVITATION TO BID

Separate sealed bids for **Wilkerson Road Widening, HWEI Project No. 2021110**, will be received by the City of Johnson, Arkansas at 2904 Main Drive, Fayetteville, Arkansas 72704 until 10:00 a.m. (local time), on Tuesday, October 2, 2023, at which time and location bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed "City of Johnson" and shall be labeled "Bid for Wilkerson Road Widening, HWEI Project No. 2021110". Bidders shall include their Arkansas license number on the outside of their sealed bids. Any bid received after the scheduled opening time will be returned unopened.

This project includes the construction of Wilkerson Road and Main Drive widening improvements including street, drainage, water and sewer, electrical, landscaping, and traffic signal improvements in Johnson, Arkansas.

Bidders will be required to inform themselves of all Addenda duly issued in accordance with the requirements provided in the Instructions to Bidders. Information regarding the number of Addenda that have been duly issued can be obtained from Hawkins-Weir Engineers.

Each Bidder must deposit with their Bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

All Bidders must be licensed in conformance with the Arkansas State Licensing Law for Commercial Contractors as defined in Arkansas Code 17-25-101 and related statutes.

The City of Johnson reserves the right to waive any informalities and reject any and all Bids. Bids shall remain firm for a period not to exceed 60 days from the Bid opening date.
